Who are we?

We are a Province-wide lobby group founded in 1974 to be *The Voice of the Freshwater Sport Fishing Industry* - one of British Columbia's pioneer industries. Our regular membership is made up of owners of freshwater fishing resorts, camps or guides located throughout British Columbia. Our associate members are businesses that relate in a variety of ways to the regular membership. BC Fishing Resorts and Outfitters Association (BCFROA) and our members are dedicated to providing a quality experience for our guests and to fostering an appreciation among all resource users, for the richness and sensitivity of our natural environment. The BCFROA works with others in the public and private sectors to protect areas from abuse and to "Preserve the Experience" of the wilderness for the enjoyment of future generations.

Change and Cooperation

In the 1970's the BCFROA worked with the insurance industry to initiate coverage for its members. This original policy has grown to offer unique features that are only available to our members. We created a Group Bonding Program in co-operation with the Ministry of Environment and Lands that frees up funds for operational requirements, funds that otherwise would be required for a performance bond. To celebrate the 20th year of our existence we created the Sandy Sandiford bursary to assist those taking a tourism degree at Thompson Rivers University.

The BCFROA and its members are part of the ongoing Land Resource Management Planning (LMRP) Sessions, the Protected Area Strategy, the Backcountry Recreation Policy (BRP) and a myriad of other consensus based consultative processes. We also participated as a steering committee member of the Freshwater Recreational Fisheries Strategy Group.

For nearly a decade the BCFROA has represented tourism on the Third Party Aboriginal Treaty Advisory Board.

Industry to Industry partnerships

The BCFROA is not solely concerned with only those issues that impact our segment of the Tourism Industry. We are represented on the Board of the Council of Tourism Associations (COTA), an umbrella group whose mandate is:

"to advocate the interests of Associations whose members are engaged primarily in tourism related services through making representations to Provincial and Federal Government, the business community and associated media in order to inform them of the opportunities and concerns of the sector.

The secondary purpose of the society is to promote Tourism into and within the province of British Columbia."
